

DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE HEALTH INSURANCE?

If your child has no health insurance, we can help you apply for insurance through the state of Colorado. CHP+ (Child Health Plan Plus) is a free or inexpensive health insurance plan that covers Well-child check-ups, doctor visits, immunizations, hospital stays, dental care, eye exams and glasses, hearing aids, prescriptions, and mental health services.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Children 18 or younger
- Children living in Colorado
- Children who are U.S. citizens or permanent U.S. residents for at least 5 years, Children who have asylum, or children who are refugees
- Children who have no health insurance
- Families who meet specific income limits
